Will your boat have a motor or sails?

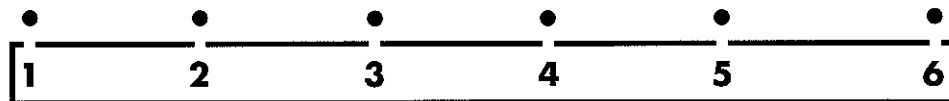
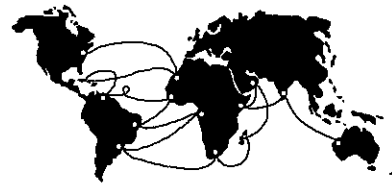
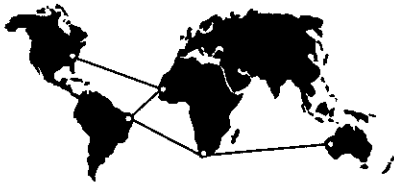
