Materials and Supplies Required

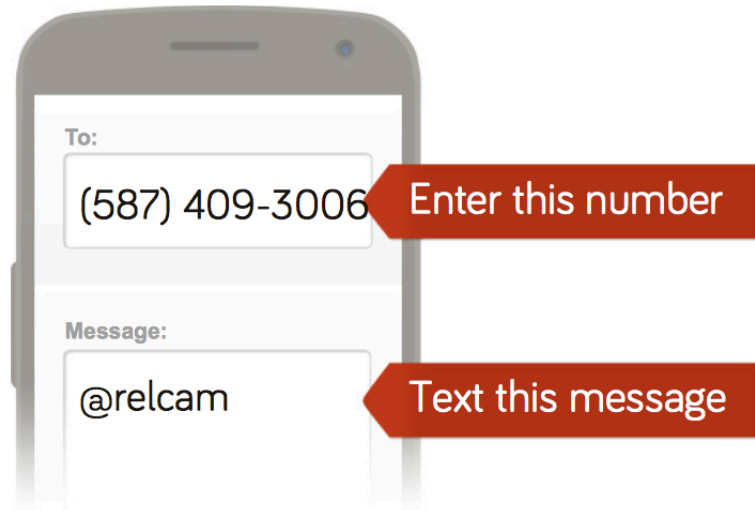
- 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper and dividers (10 units of study)

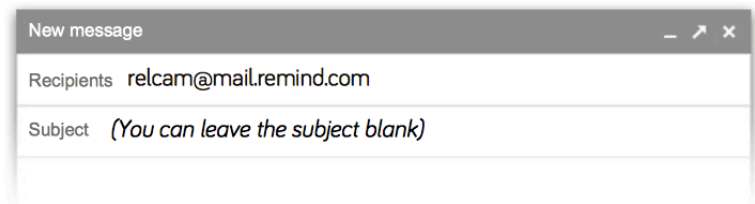


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
