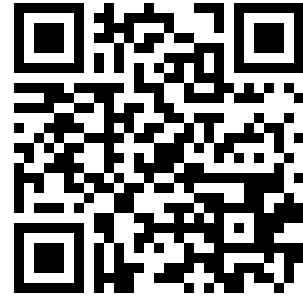


# Religion 8 – Course Outline

### General Information
